Camp Bayview Reservation Deposit

The deposit for reservation of Camp Bayview for overnight or day use is \$200.00.

Deposits are refundable and will be mailed out upon a satisfactory check-out from the Camp Ranger at departure. Troops/Groups who do not receive a satisfactory check-out will not be refunded their deposit. If damages exceed the deposit amount, the troop or group will be expected to pay the difference, and an increased deposit amount will be requested for that troop's or group's future use of Camp Bayview.

Cancellations

Cancellations of reservations must be made two weeks in advance of the arrival date. Cancellations with less than two weeks notice or "No shows" will not be refunded their full deposit. \$75 will be held for overnight reservations and \$50 will be held for day reservations.

Campers with Special Needs

Camp Bayview is handicapped accessible. If you have a camper with special needs, make sure that all needs are listed on the parent permission form by the parent. It is the responsibility of the Troop or Group Leader to make sure that all special needs are met. Let the Camp Ranger know of any specifics.

Men & Camping

Troops may be accompanied by men (registered Girl Scout members, such as husbands, leaders, or fathers or campers) while camping at Camp Bayview. Troops need to make proper arrangements for any men accompanying their troop, including separate sleeping facilities. Please follow the guidelines given in the Troop Camp Consultant Training and also in *Safety-Wise* (page 69).

Agreement to Terms of Use

As the leader of the troop/group, I agree to:

- Meet all requirements for troop camping as stated in *Safety-Wise* including permission from each girl's parent or guardian.
- Be accompanied by an adult First Aider who is certified in First Aid and CPR. A medical doctor or nurse is an acceptable alternative. Documentation must be submitted with this reservation form.
- Provide a Troop Camp Consultant trained adult who is present on site at all times.
- Comply with the rules and regulations of Camp Bayview, as outlined in the Camp Guidelines.
- Leave camp better than I found it when I arrived.
- Prohibit alcoholic beverages, drugs, or firearms from the premises.

I understand that troops who do not comply with Girl Scout policies and procedures will not be allowed to use Camp Bayview.

I have read the standards and activity points in *Safety-Wise* and the Camp Guidelines and all rules and regulations pertaining to Girl Scout camping. I will observe all standards and I certify that the information on this form is accurate.
