Honor Pin

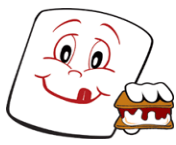

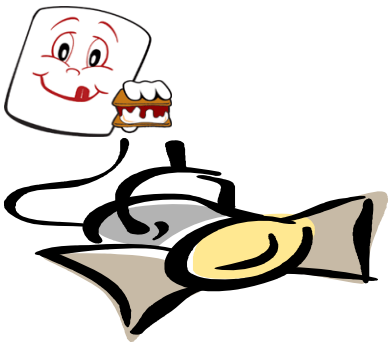

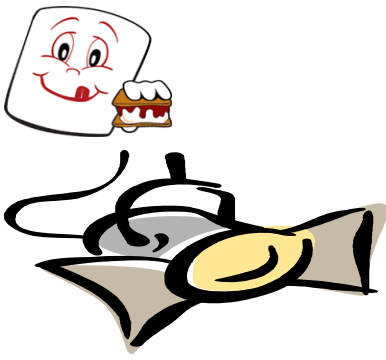
