

Canoeing on the Guadalupe River

**Canoe Training is mandatory for all girls
and adults who attend the trip.**
Participants who have attended training
previously are not required to attend again.

LOCATION: We will be canoeing on the Guadalupe River, 45 miles north of San Antonio, TX. The trail is approximately 17 miles long, starting at the Sultenfuss Crossing at FM 3351, and ending at the Guadalupe Canoe Livery at Highway 281. We will begin the trail on Saturday, spend the night halfway through the canoe trail at the Guadalupe River State Park, and then complete the trail on Sunday.

TRAINING: Canoe training is required for girls and adults to participate in the event. Those who attended the training in previous years are not required to attend this year, but are welcome to attend if space allows. The training will take place at Camp Green Hill on September 4th from 10 am – 4 pm.

FEE: The \$30.00 fee covers the cost of training, campsite reservations at the park, rental of canoes and lifejackets, and a patch. **The fee does not include the price of food, transportation, or additional supplies.** Participants will be designated into teams during training, which will plan their own meals and divide the cost amongst them. The cost of carpooling should be divided amongst the passengers in each car. Every participant is responsible for their own camping supplies, water shoes, and other equipment.

SUPPLIES: Every participant will bring their own food, camping supplies, water shoes, and other equipment. Canoe, paddle, and lifejacket will be provided. You may bring your own lifejacket, if you have a U.S. Coast Guard approved PFD. A packing list will be included in the welcome packet sent to each participant upon registration.

PHYSICAL DEMAND: Activities on this trip will be physically demanding. Girls must be in good physical condition. The 17-mile canoe trail will take approximately 10-12 hours to complete (5-6 hours each day), and will require participants to control their canoe for the duration of this time. Due to this physical demand, a health exam signed by a physician within the past 24 months is required for each girl participant.

Minimum number of participants for event: 10 / Maximum: 26
Adults attend as event volunteers. Adult spaces are limited.
