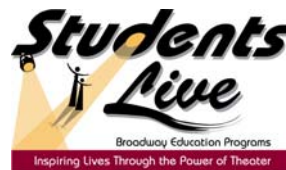

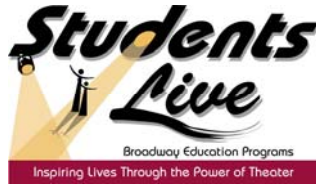

***Cirque Du Soleil* “Become Your Own Ring Master” Project**

Cirque Du Soleil: "Circus of the Sun"- "A dramatic mix of circus arts and street entertainment that presents performances with a synthesis of circus styles from around the world, and their own central themes and storylines."

Zarkana: "Expect the unexpected as things are not what they always appear to be."

Clowning: "A comic performer, as in a circus, theatrical production, or the like, who wears an outlandish costume and makeup and entertains by pantomiming common situations or actions in exaggerated or ridiculous fashion, by juggling or tumbling, etc."

Imagination: "Imagining, or forming mental images or concepts of what is not actually present to the senses."

Using one of the largest themes found in *Cirque Du Soleil's Zarkana* "things are not what they always appear to be", *StudentsLive* invites **YOU** to share with the audience at the *Cirque Du Soleil's Zarkana Workshop* an imaginative clowning performance that is one to two minutes (maximum) in length. This project should reflect how using your imagination to turn someone's "expected perception" has helped create a positive change in the world or someone around us in a better way and ultimately, help in becoming a better person, aka the "Ring Master" of your life.

StudentsLive is providing the music selection from *Cirque Du Soleil's* performances for your project that will accompany your presentation. Please outline your piece to reflect the feeling, rhythm and style of the music and be timed to fit the music from start to end. The song selection MP3s are attached above. To download the music, click on the attached MP3 files and play them in your preferred Media Player.

If you submit as a Group and your Group is one of the selected 5 finalists, there is a maximum of 5 presenters allowed on stage from your Troop/Class. You will receive further information and details about the presentation if selected.

All Project submissions for June 25, 2011 must be submitted by **April 24, 2011** and for October 1, 2011, all Projects must be submitted by **July 31, 2011**. The *StudentsLive* team will contact all submittants by **April 25, 2011** for the June 25, 2011 date or **August 1, 2011** for the October 1, 2011 date to announce the finalists.
