Safe Sitter is a medically accurate babysitting preparation program that teaches girls ages 11-17 how to handle emergencies when caring for children. The nationally recognized program teaches safe and nurturing child care techniques, behavior management skills and how to recognize a medical emergency and know the appropriate action to take. The babysitter must be able to handle whatever situation arises.

- Babysitting business skills
- Basic child care skills (diapering, feeding etc)
- How to entertain children and keep them safe
