Muriel Cotman - G.O.A.L.S.-Get Out There and Love Speaking Cueld, $T\chi$

Muriel wanted to address the common fear of public speaking. Muriel led a workshop at the Boys and Girls Club of DeWitt County to equip and encourage young people to Get Out there and Love Speaking (G.O.A.L.S.). The workshop provided a non-competitive, encouraging environment for young people to learn and practice communication skills. She had a group of 20 students, grades 3rd and 4th attend the workshop. Muriel was able to provide youth with a positive speaking experience to make them more open to public speaking. She was able to put together G.O.A.L.S. kits that are available free to anyone in the community of DeWitt County.



Hannah Edelstein - Helping Women Take Charge: Cleaning for Independence Brownsville, TX

Hannah Edelstein wanted to address the issue of domestic violence while assisting local non-profit, Friendship of Women, Inc. Hannah worked with fellow Girl Scouts, businesses, community organizations and individual volunteers for the project that added a laundry room with three commercial washers and driers, plus a covered walkway connecting it to the shelter. Most importantly, she prepared an educational power point presentation to raise awareness of the needs of abused families, the needs of Friendship of Women, which services families from all over the Rio Grande Valley, and to raise community involvement in helping victims and organizations who support families in need.



Victoria Hinojos- Cadettes for Friendship of Women Brownsville, TX

Victoria Hinojos wanted to help women in abusive relationships at Friendship of Women, Inc.. Victoria knew the greatest need when women leave an abusive relationship is the need for clean clothes. While the shelter had a closet with a washer and dryer for the clients (victims) to use, the demand for clean clothes was great. Therefore, a new laundry room was needed. The clients clean clothes not only provides a sense of cleanliness, but also a sense of safety and comfort in a difficult situation. The new laundry room not only benefited the clients, but the shelter staff, who have to wash and dry the sheets, towels, and linens as clients come and go.



Jasmine Leal— Rainbow Room Library for Forsaken Angels Mission, TX

Jasmine Leal saw a need of a Library at Child Protective Services (CPS). The Library within CPS is titled Rainbow Room Library for Forsaken Angels. She wanted to help fill a gap for children of all ages that are involved with CPS. Jasmine wanted the children to be able to have a space to read books while waiting for placement. She realized that many of these children are disadvantaged and never have access to literature. Jasmine's hope was the library would be the inspiration to help foster kids everywhere to have an escape through literature during their troubled time in their lives.


