

# GSGST Do-Dad Patch



## Requirements for Dads to earn:

- Have a daughter in Girl Scouts.
- Be a registered adult Girl Scout member.
- Have a Volunteer Application and Criminal Background check completed.
- Perform one or more of the following services on at least 2 occasions during the course of a registration year.

## Choices of Service Include

- Serve in any of the volunteer positions after receiving appropriate training:
  - Leader or co-leader for a Girl Scout troop
  - Director or Assistant for a Girl Scout series, camp, or event
  - Troop or community/service unit product sales coordinator
  - Community/service unit team member such as Event Coordinator, Accounting Coordinator, or Recruiter
  - Travel Pathway Coordinator, supporting girl travel opportunities
  - Facilitator/Trainer for First Aid and CPR, Leadership Essentials, Archery, Troop Camp Consultant, or any other adult learning opportunity
- Attend at least 3 booth sales with a troop or group of girls during the Girl Scout cookie sale
- Serve as a certified First Aider (to meet requirements stated in *Volunteer Essentials*) for a Girl Scout troop or group.
- Become a certified Troop Camp Consultant and attend a Girl Scout outing in this capacity.
- Assist troop in a community service or take action project.
- Adopt a project at a Clean-Up Day at Camp Green Hill or Camp Bayview.

## Awarding the Patch

- The patch will be awarded to any father who meets the above qualifications. Troop Leaders are able to purchase the patches from council shops.
- Patches are awarded for the first year that the qualifications are met.
- A Do-Dad continuing in the program for a second or consecutive year will be awarded a star to be attached to the patch.
