



Astronomy Club Patch Program

Grade Level Requirements:

To earn this patch, complete activities and mark on Tracking Sheet (back of this). Complete activities 1, 2 and 3 PLUS each grade level must also complete the minimum number of additional activities. Daisies=2 more activities, Brownies=3 more activities, Juniors=5 more activities, Cadettes=7 more activities, Seniors & Ambassadors=8 more activities.

- 1. Go on a night hike and observe the stars in the sky (or at a planetarium) and identify at least three constellations.
- 2. Make a planisphere (also known as a star wheel or star chart). Use it to help identify the stars and constellations in the night sky.
- 3. Identify and learn about two females who contributed to the field of astronomy and share at Troop or Service Unit event.
- 4. Attend a Camp event related to space or astronomy.
- 5. Find the North Star through a telescope.
- 6. Learn about the history of space exploration.
- 7. Using a real constellation, draw a figure connecting many of the stars in a new way and create a legend to go with it. Share your story with your group or another group.
- 8. Look at images from the Hubble telescope and create a piece of art inspired by one of the images.
- 9. Learn the difference between a planetarium and observatory. Visit one if possible.
- 10. Learn how to use a sundial and make one.
- 11. Make a diagram of a comet and its parts.
- 12. Learn how to use a star map.
- 13. Start an astronomy club with your troop that you can meet with on campouts.
- 14. Learn about moon myths from at least two cultures.
- 15. Identify the star closest to earth and list five facts about it.
- 16. Make the solar system to scale—it can be a drawing, a model or a 3D piece of art.
- 17. Identify two college-level astronomy courses that are offered at a college or university near you.
- 18. Learn what constellations are visible for each season
- 19. Identify one astronomy-related career. Find out what type of education you would need to get the job, what typical job duties it would entail and what the salary range would be.
- 20. Create a piece of art in any medium inspired by something found in the night sky.
- 21. For older girls: Develop and/or lead an activity or event where you help younger girls meet one of the other requirements for this patch.
- 22. Learn which of the nine planets are visible to the naked eye. Try to locate at least one of these during a star gazing adventure.
