About the Fall Product Program

The Fall Product Program is a council-sponsored program that combines educational activities with money earning opportunities for the troops. During the program, Girl Scouts offer nuts, candy, magazines and other online items to their customers. This program allows troops to earn funds at the beginning of the Girl Scout year, while helping girls gain experience: goal setting, decision making, money management, people skill and business ethics.

Set a Goal

What's your Girl Scout's Goal? Does she want to help the troop earn money for an upcoming activity? Does she want to earn a special reward from the order card? Whatever it is, be sure to set a Goal first.

Set-Up the Girl's Online Program

- M2 (Online operating system) will open up to allow you to begin setting up your girl's online program. To access the system, go to http://www.gsnutsandmags.com/gsgst
- Girl will be able to customize their online program with their personalized avatar, pictures and a special video message to their customer.

Collect Orders & Thank Customers

- Send 18+ emails to family and friends inviting them to shop your girl's online program from Step 2.
- Text & share your online program link to social media. Family and friends will be able to shop on the go.
- Jot down orders taken in person on the nut/candy order card. Be sure to collect money for all orders.
- Remember: Parent/ Caregiver must enter any paper order into your Girl Scout's M2 account by October 29th.

Turn in Money & Paperwork to Troop

Verify all paper order for accuracy and payment. Make sure you get a receipt for the money you turn
in to the troop.

Online Items & Direct Ship

- Girls and Troops can continue to share their online sales link to their family/friends.
- All orders will count towards individual girl rewards and troop proceeds.

Deliver Your Orders to the Customers

- Your troop leader will notify you when your "Girl-Delivered" nut/candy items are ready for pick-up to deliver to your customers.
- Girl Rewards will arrive in late November.
